ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the 'Best Practices Award' was instituted to reward those who have achieved excellent results in good governance and successfully implemented strategies, new initiatives and best practices. The award carries a cash reward of Rs.2.00 lakhs each for three chosen nominations.

2. The nominations for Best Practices Award are received under three categories, viz., (i) Government employees – individual; (ii) Government employees – as a group; and (iii) Organisation / Institution / Office.

3. As many as 42 (forty two) nominations were received for the Best Practices Award, 2020 and the Screening Committee for the award in its meeting held on 06.08.2020 under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Finance Department scrutinised the nominations and has recommended 12 (twelve) nominations. The 12 (twelve) nominations recommended by the Screening Committee were placed before the Selection Committee in its meeting held on 07.08.2020 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government. The Selection Committee scrutinised the nominations for the "Best Practices Award" under the categories of 'Organisation' and 'Individual'. The Committee after detailed deliberations decided to recommend the following six nominations for the Best Practices Award, 2020:-

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| i. | Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture & Plantation Crops and Agricultural Engineering for adopting innovative water conservation strategies that enabled Tamil Nadu achieve first position in the Country in Micro Irrigation |

ii.	Department of Treasuries and Accounts for conceptualizing Integrated Financial and Human Resources Management System (IFHRMS) for total computerization of Finance, Treasury, Human Resources and Pension Management Processes of the State
iii.	Higher Education Department for facilitating online admissions to Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Diploma Courses
iv.	Greater Chennai Corporation for conducting Fever Clinics across Chennai to break transmission chain of COVID-19 pandemic
v.	Commissionerate of Municipal Administration for removal of legacy waste through bio remediation and bio-mining process in Urban Local Bodies
vi.	Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department for application of ICT for promoting safe sanitation practices in rural areas

4. The Selection Committee has also recommended that as a token of appreciation of the special initiatives taken by the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation for various steps taken to ensure uninterrupted availability of drugs needed for combating COVID-19 pandemic and the Cyber Crime Wing of Tamil Nadu Police for developing a computer based model for tracing potential contacts of COVID-19 positive persons by analysing various available details, a Certificate of Appreciation to each of them may be given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister.

5. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee and after careful examination of the nominations, Government have decided that the 'Best Practices Award, 2020' be given to the three initiatives, the details of which are given below:-

7. Accepting the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the Government also direct that a 'Certificate of Appreciation' shall be given to

Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation for various steps taken to ensure uninterrupted availability of drugs needed for combating COVID-19 pandemic and to the Cyber Crime Wing of Tamil Nadu Police for developing a computer based model for tracing potential contacts of COVID-19 positive persons by analysing various available details. The Certificates will be given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the celebrations of the Independence Day-2020.


