ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the 'Best Practices Award' was instituted to reward those who have achieved excellent results in good governance and successfully implemented strategies, new initiatives and best practices. The award carries a cash reward of Rs.2.00 lakhs each for three chosen nominations.

2. The nominations for Best Practices Award are received under three categories, viz., (i) Government employees – individual; (ii) Government employees – as a group; and (iii) Organisation / Institution / Office.

3. As many as 42 (forty two) nominations were received for the Best Practices Award, 2019 and the Screening Committee for the award in its meeting held on 25.07.2019 under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department scrutinised the nominations and has recommended 7 (seven) nominations. The 7 (seven) nominations recommended by the Screening Committee were placed before the Selection Committee in its meeting held on 01.08.2019 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government. The Selection Committee scrutinised the nominations for the "Best Practices Award" under the categories of 'Organisation' and 'Group'. The Committee after detailed deliberations decided to recommend the following four nominations for the Best Practices Award, 2019:-

i.	Greater Chennai Police Commissionerate for installation of 'third eye' – closed circuit television cameras and using 'Facetagr app' for crime detection.
ii.	Greater Chennai Corporation for establishing "Infinity Park at Santhome as a pilot project for creating sensory parks for differently abled children under Smart City Project".

iii.	Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj for Naganathi River Rejuvenation Project in Vellore district under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS).
iv.	Department of Commercial Taxes for developing a mobile app and establishing a 24x7 help desk to provide assistance for migration to GST system.

4. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee and after careful examination of the nominations, Government have decided that the 'Best Practices Award, 2019' be given to the three initiatives the details of which are given below:

6. The Government have also decided to present a 'Certificate of Appreciation' to Greater Chennai Corporation for establishing "Infinity Park at Santhome as a pilot project for creating sensory parks for differently abled children under Smart City Project".
